

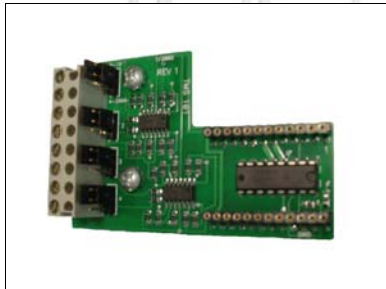
## Accessory Devices

### Product Overview

#### Basyx M24 Modem

The Basyx M24 is a plug-in modem which provides remote communications with the system.

The modem is a 2400 baud chip modem, and plugs directly into the modem socket on a PSC or 100 controller. The modem may be added to any board also containing the AOB analog output board as described below.



#### Basyx AOB Analog Output Board

The AOB analog output board provides four (4) jumper selectable, modulating 0-10vdc or 0-20ma outputs for control of valves, dampers, fan drives or other modulating devices.

The AOB plugs directly into the modem socket on PSC or 100 controllers, with a pass-thru connection for insertion of the optional modem as listed above.
